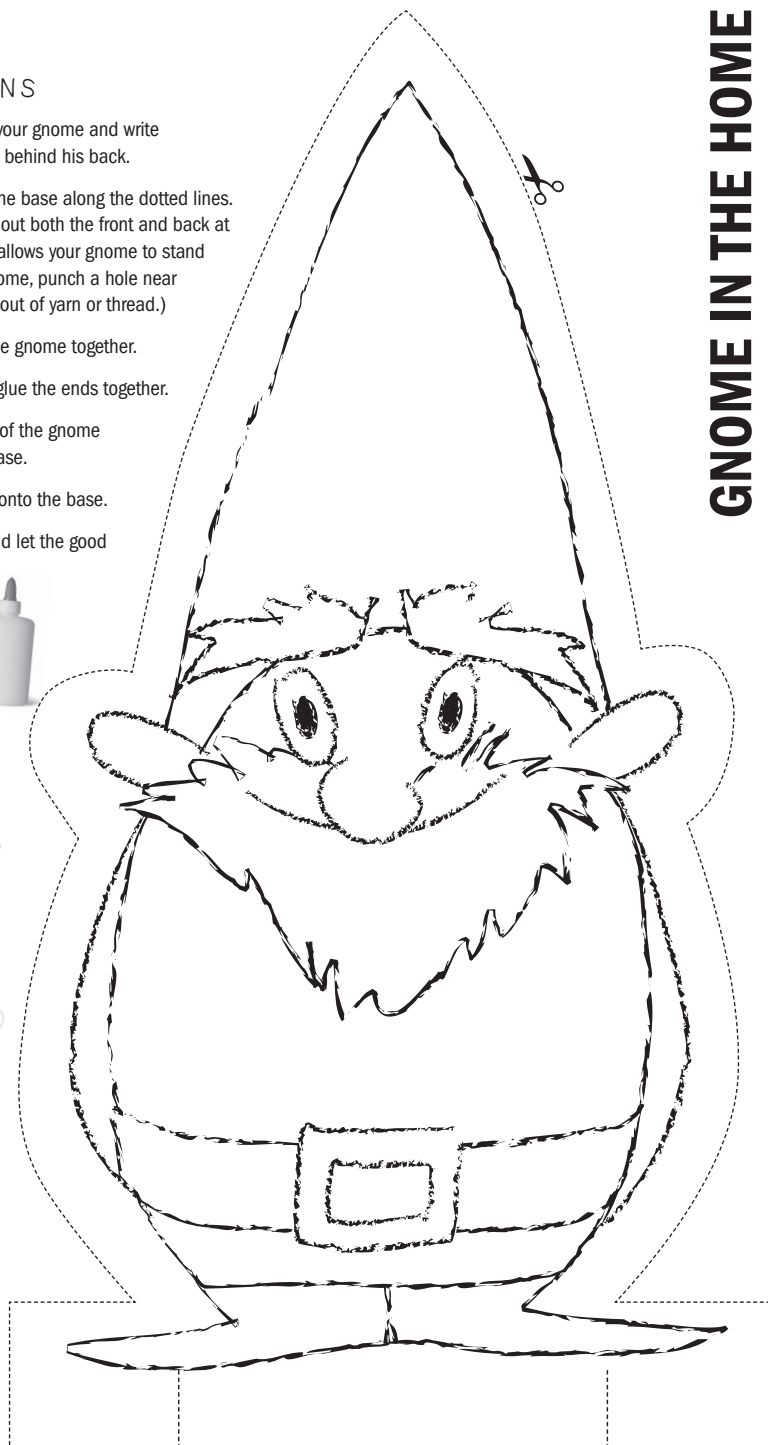
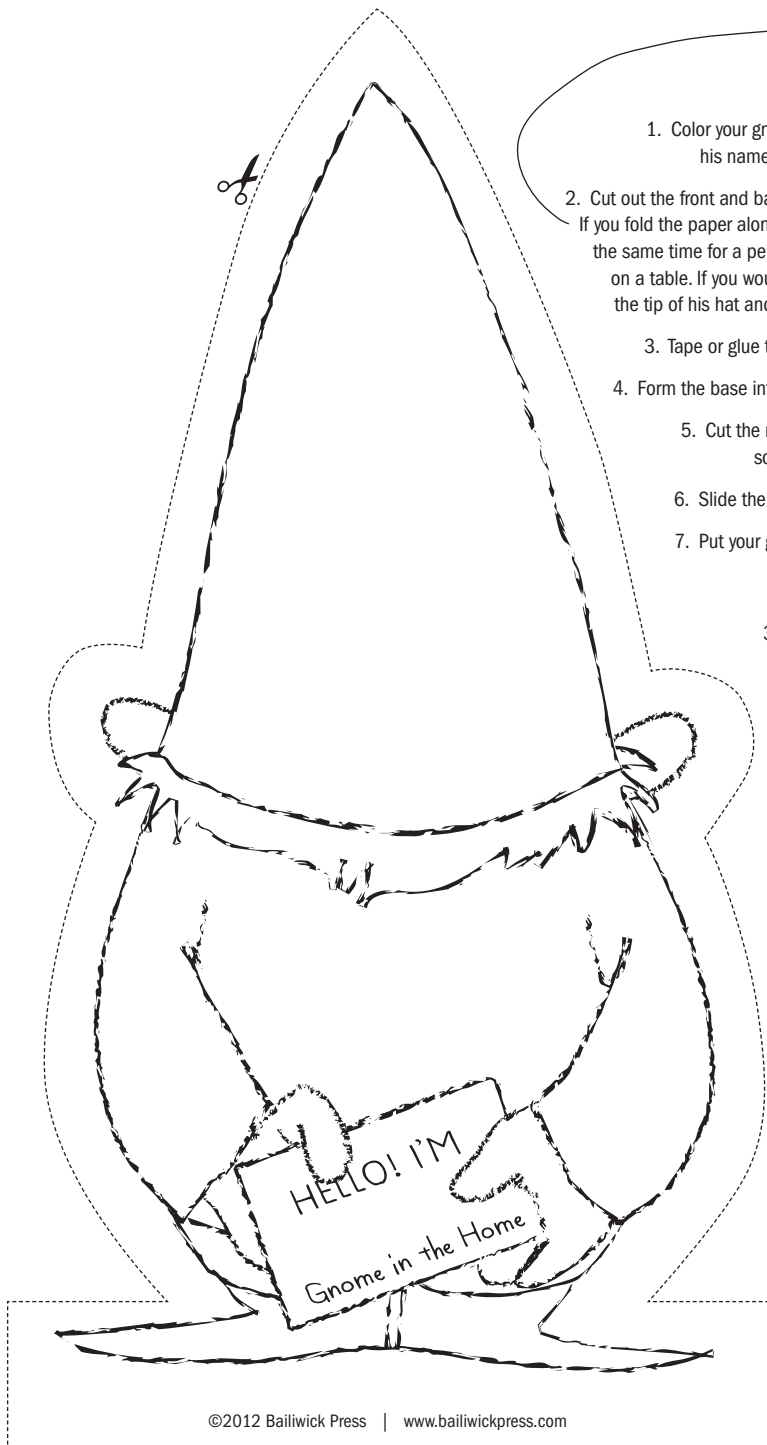


INSTRUCTIONS

1. Color your gnome and base. Name your gnome and write his name on the paper he holds behind his back.
2. Cut out the front and back of the gnome and the base along the dotted lines. If you fold the paper along this line, you can cut out both the front and back at the same time for a perfect match. (The base allows your gnome to stand on a table. If you would rather hang your gnome, punch a hole near the tip of his hat and make a hanging loop out of yarn or thread.)
3. Tape or glue the front and back of the gnome together.
4. Form the base into a circle and tape or glue the ends together.
5. Cut the notches on the bottom of the gnome so it will slide onto the base.
6. Slide the notches of the gnome onto the base.
7. Put your gnome in your home and let the good behavior begin!
